



2010 Legislative Priorities

Revenue Sharing

The Alaska Municipal League supports full funding of \$60 million into the Revenue Sharing Fund; and the appropriation of the full \$60 million from the Revenue Sharing Fund into the FY2011 budget, to the communities, allowing for inflation, while yet realizing our ultimate long-term goal is 6% of state natural resource revenues.

Energy

The Alaska Municipal League supports the development of a comprehensive energy plan and implementation strategy to meet the energy needs of citizens and communities throughout the state, in the most efficient and cost effective manner.

Transportation

The Alaska Municipal League supports the development of a long-term sustainable transportation funding mechanism of Alaska, especially important in the looming bankruptcy of the U.S. Federal Transportation Trust Fund.

Education

The Alaska Municipal League supports long-term forward funding of an adequate and equitable education foundation program, school debt reimbursement and construction; and, opposes any change in the Alaska Foundation Formula that would increase the burden to local government.
