The City of Seward, Alaska is recruiting for an Interim City Manager.

\$20 Million + budget; 96 year-round employees; home rule city with Mayor and six Council Members; city-wide year-round population approximately 2,700, summer 10,000. Services include fire, police, library, harbor, electric, water/wastewater, streets, parks & recreation, and parking.

Seward is Alaska's third largest visitor destination with an average of 73 cruise ship calls and 300,000 visitors annually. Located 120 miles south of Anchorage, via a National Scenic Byway, with the state's busiest harbor, the best viewable glacier, and a busy cruise ship port. Seward is experiencing strong growth, has a healthy and diverse business community, and is both benefiting and challenged by that growth.

Requirements include a Masters degree in Public/Business Administration preferred or a Bachelor's Degree in Public/Business Administration; **and** five years' experience in a senior management position, preferably in the public sector; **or** equivalent. Ideal candidate has varied experience in finance, project management, community development, tourism impacts, and human resources with strong communication skills. Growth and utility management skills are desirable as is a strong record in local government management success, and candidate must be familiar with Title 29 of the Alaska statutes.

Required to reside in the City of Seward during tenure in office. Salary depends on qualifications plus health and retirement benefits and car allowance.
