

City of Valdez-GIS Manager

The City of Valdez is accepting online applications for the position of GIS Manager. Under the direction of the Community Development Director the GIS Manager designs, operates, oversees and maintains the City of Valdez Geographic Information System. This position will coordinate GIS activities among all City Departments and between the City, the community, and other organizations. This position will also coordinate, manage and direct GIS database & application development, definitions, maintenance and implementation. The GIS Manager manages & prepares general planning for the GIS system, provides assistance and coordination of drafting, mapping, graphic illustrations and related reporting for the City. This position will also train other GIS operators.

Qualified candidates must have the following skills & educations to be considered for this position:

- Bachelor's Degree from an accredited college in GIS, Cartography or Geography with an emphasis in GIS;
- 5 years progressively responsible experience implementing and integrating GIS applications, including considerable progressively responsible GIS work;
- Or an equivalent combination of education, certification & work experience-Master's Degree Preferred;
- Prior experience in local government GIS and implementing enterprise systems preferred;
- Must have high level of written and oral communication skills;
- Must be able to establish cooperative and effective working relationships with others;
- Must be proficient in ArcGIS, ArcSDE, AutoCad, object-oriented programming and SQL Server.
