

The City of Valdez is accepting online applications for a Port & Harbor Maintenance/Project Manager. Under general supervision of the Ports and Harbor Director, supervises all regular maintenance activities, minor construction and repair, and is responsible for the direct supervision of assigned personnel to ensure the quality function, maintenance, and security of all airport, marine, and industrial properties and infrastructure for the safe and reliable use of the Ports and Harbor of Valdez by commercial clients and the public. The incumbent is also responsible for maintaining the budget for personal services, materials, equipment, supplies, and contractual services.

Application & Resume should reflect the general knowledge of Maritime Security Procedures, State & Federal port & marine laws, ordinances and regulations; Marine structures & terminology; Construction trades such as carpentry, paving, earth work, roofing, pipe laying, painting, concrete work, basic surveying techniques, landscape maintenance and horticulture, heavy equipment operation, facility maintenance, electrical and plumbing, welding and other metal work fabrication; OSHA principles and practices; Knowledge of principles and practices of organization, administration, budget, and management relative to planning, implementing, and administering a facilities maintenance program.

Successful applicants should meet the minimum requirements of:

- Valid AKDL with clean driving record
- Valid TWIC card
- Associates Degree & five (5) years' experience in marine or facility maintenance, or an equivalent combination of education & experience
- Three (3) years of progressively responsible supervisory experience in a position similar to a Port or Harbor Maintenance Foreman, Project Manager, or similar classification involving construction and/or maintenance and repair related to building and marine facilities maintenance.
