What is the Conference of Young Alaskans?

The mission of the Conference of Young Alaskans (COYA) is to connect young Alaskans to a rich history, a vibrant present and a thriving future. Framed by historic and current lessons, young Alaskan leaders apply their knowledge and creativity to visions, goals and proposed actions for the state and its people. Representing a diverse array of communities, delegates will deliberate on five themes impacting Alaska's local governments. COYA delegates develop respect for Alaska's past and present leaders, discover insights into the challenges facing the diverse regions of Alaska and find inspiration for making a difference in our State's future through a municipal-focused lens.

This year, COYA will convene in Fairbanks. COYA delegates will meet, deliberate and work together to formulate proposed actions for Alaska's local governments. Delegates will present their results to the Alaska Conference of Mayors to showcase their policy outcomes and conclusions. Outcomes will be shared with our Governor, Congressional Delegation, and State policy makers, as well as with AML partners and conference sponsors.

The selection process includes applicants to describe their vision for Alaska's future and their role in it. 55 delegates will be chosen to participate in this unique, experiential opportunity. Delegates will be selected based on the strength of their application, leadership capacity and geographical and cultural perspectives.



Sponsor Opportunities

COYA is a unique, high-quality and prestigious event that highlights young Alaskans and their commitment to healthy and vibrant cities in Alaska. The following sponsor opportunities allow businesses and organizations a way to express the value they place in developing thoughtful, informed and responsible young leaders. This exceptional opportunity will bring 55 young Alaskans together with some of Alaska's top business, community and political leaders. Established leaders will be present to answer questions about leadership and their role in the community.

The Ambassador Dinner will be named in honor of the sponsor and we invite active participation.

\$5,000 Hospitality Partner (eight opportunities):

Eight meal opportunities provide corporate sponsors the opportunity to introduce themselves and their organization. Your logo and banner will be highlighted at the meal associated with your sponsorship.

\$3,000 Delegate Sponsor (55 opportunities): The direct cost for each delegate to participate is approximately \$3,000. Your contribution directly covers lodging, meals and ground transportation. You will be recognized as a delegate sponsor in the delegate program.

\$2,500 Social Sponsors (Two opportunities): Two scheduled social events provide delegates the opportunity to connect with each other in a social setting.
