Kodiak Island Borough Clerk Nova Javier received the prestigious Clerk of the Year Award on November 13, 2018, at the annual Alaska Association of Municipal Clerks (AAMC) conference in Anchorage, AK.

This award was established in 2000 to recognize Alaska municipal clerks who have made significant contributions toward furthering the municipal clerk profession, improving municipal government, continuing professional development through education, demonstrating leadership, and making significant contributions to the quality of life in their community.

Ms. Javier is a former president of the Alaska Association of Municipal Clerks, has mentored Clerks throughout Alaska, has served on numerous AAMC committees, and has presented sessions at the annual AAMC conferences about the role of the clerk and election process. In addition, she has presented sessions to Kodiak community groups about parliamentary procedure and municipal government careers. She earned her Certified Municipal Clerk designation in August 2004 and her Master Municipal Clerk designation in April 2009.

Ms. Javier was nominated for this award by her Mayor, Assembly, and staff for her extraordinary 18-year service in municipal government. In his nomination letter Kodiak Island Borough Mayor Daniel Rohrer noted Nova's recognition by the Consulate General of the Philippines for her service to the consular outreach program to Kodiak, and he praised her impartiality, humility, and service and dedication to the Clerk profession, local government, and citizens of the Kodiak Island Borough.
