



# AFD COVID-19 SELF-SCREENING GUIDELINES



Version – 4/13/2020

1. At the beginning of every shift, employees entering the station or work site shall complete a screening and self-check at the designated single point of entry.
2. The supervisor is responsible to ensure members are following the screening criteria below.
3. For 56-hr employees, screening is also reevaluated mid-shift, with a final screening prior to end of shift.
4. If FeverWatchers IR scanner or personal thermometer is used initially, and temp is 100° F or greater, retake with SureTemp oral thermometer if disposable probe covers are in stock.
5. No need for documentation - this is simply a “sick” or “not sick” evaluation tool.
6. Employees with one or more of these symptoms are considered to have a communicable illness and should self-isolate or go to their vehicle pending further guidance.
7. Supervisor should notify their Chain of Command and contact the HSO for further employee guidance (907-223-4204). Employee will be sent home, referred to their HCP for evaluation, or referred for COVID-19 screening and testing with prescription from Dr. Levy.
