RESOLUTION NO. 20200413-03

A RESOLUTION of The City of Eagle Declaring a State of Emergency

WHEREAS, The World Health Organization, The United States Government and the Governor of Alaska all advise that COVID-19 is highly contagious and presents a serious health risk to All Americans, including severe illness and death; and

WHEREAS, a proactive approach must be taken by both individuals and communities to slow the rate of infection to reduce negative impact on our health care system; and

WHEREAS, a declaration of a local Emergency will alert the public to the seriousness of the risk as well as provide a mechanism for the City to coordinate its response and resources with local State and Federal agencies; and

THEREFORE: The Eagle City Council declares an Emergency based on the threat of COVID-19 and authorizes the Mayor, in accordance with AS 26.23.140, exercise to act as the incident commander for the City, to activate the Emergency Response Plan, exercise all authority vested in the position by applicable local state and Federal law as well as directing the Mayor to procure services and contracts necessary to address this emergency and combat the spread of COVID-19. This declaration is effective until the virus is no longer declared a federal or state emergency.

ADOPTED by a majority roll call vote of the Eagle City Council this 13th day of April, 2020.
