DECLARATION EMERGENCY EXTENSION A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LARSEN BAY AND THE NATIVE VILLAGE OF LARSEN BAY AUTHORIZING PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES TO PROTECT THE HEALTH, WELFARE, AND SAFETY OF THE RESIDENTS OF THE CITY AND NATIVE VILLAGE OF LARSEN BAY

Resolution No. 20-04

WHEREAS, the city of Larsen Bay is issuing a Disaster Emergency Declaration on 1 April 2020, due to the current and expected imminent impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic for the City of Larsen Bay; and

WHEREAS, the declaration activates the tribe's emergency response plan and request disaster assistance from the State of Alaska by making available resources as needed for the ongoing response and recovery from the current and potential impacts to provide individual assistance for affected businesses and individuals, and technical expertise and guidance to help the city in its response and recovery from this event; and

WHEREAS, this declaration continues for a period of fourteen days, until 15 April 2020, unless extended by consent of the council; and

WHEREAS, as the response and recovery efforts continue and are expected to require the ongoing use of the tribe resources, it is appropriate to extend the disaster declaration; and

WHEREAS, the council wishes this declaration in the best interest of the public

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF LARSEN BAY:

SECTION 1. That the declaration of local disaster emergency issued by the City of Larsen Bay on 1 April 2020, is hereby declared for a period of 14 days in order to allow for a more complete response. A copy of the declaration of disaster emergency extended by resolution is attached and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. that this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
