








Respiratory Protection Levels and Reuse of Facemasks, N95, and North Cartridges

<u>Fabric or Surgical Mask Use</u>	<u>Mask Type</u>	<u>Reuse of Mask</u>
All personnel will wear fabric or surgical masks when out in public	Homemade Fabric or Surgical Mask	
All personnel recommended to wear fabric or surgical mask in the workplace – if not wearing mask, must remain isolated from others	Homemade Fabric or Surgical Mask	
Fabric or surgical mask placed on all patients (Hot Zone)	Homemade Fabric or Surgical Mask	
<u>Proximity to Patient During Encounter</u>	<u>Respirator Type (w/ Order of Preference)</u>	<u>Reuse of N95 and Cartridge Filters</u>
Remains outside of 6-foot perimeter and confined spaces (Cold Zone ; Warm Zone) – no close or direct patient contact	N95	
Within 6 feet of <u>all Low-Risk PPE</u> patients and confined spaces - provider must be wearing face shield for N95 reuse (Hot Zone)	N95	 
Within 6 feet of <u>High-Risk PPE</u> patient (Hot Zone)	1. N95 2. North Half Mask	
All aerosol-generating treatments and procedures, includes all cardiac arrests (Hot Zone)	1. North Half Mask 2. N95
