## Non-Tribal Agencies Receiving CARES Act Funds

- Ketchikan Gateway Borough \$10 million
- City of Ketchikan \$12.2 million

# Programs

- Borough or City Administered
  - Business Relief (maximum grant: \$50K per round based on greater than 30% loss.)
  - Shelter and Food Security: Direct services
  - Rent/Mortgage Assistance: Up to \$1,200 a month through December
  - Moorage rent assistance up to 25 % each month.
  - Day Care Assistance (\$500 per child)
  - PPE supplies \$2,500 limit per round
  - Non-Profit Organization General Support:
  - School District Support for PPE and other CARES Act activities
  - AML operations support:
  - Reimburse Borough/City Expenditures

# Round 1 July- September

- **Borough**
  - Business Relief \$5 million \$50,000 maximum grant based on decline of revenues during 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter.
  - Micro Business: \$500,000
  - Shelter and Food Security: \$200,000 (Direct Social Services by City of Ketchikan)
  - Rent and Mortgage Assistance \$1.6 million. Compliments similar City of Ketchikan program (Household income limit: \$64K)
  - Day Care Assistance: \$1 million
  - PPE supplies and upgrades: \$135,000
  - Non-Profit Organization General Support: \$300,800
  - School District: \$285,000 (in addition to direct CARES Act fund .
  - Borough Expenditures: \$335,000 (Fire Fighter costs and PPE building upgrades.
  - AML COVID-19 support: \$25,000.
- **City of Saxman (Allocated from Borough CARES Act funds)**
  - Food Security: \$40,000
  - Utilities & Housing Assistance: \$296,000
  - Upgrades to City Chambers for Social Distancing: \$32,000
- **City of Ketchikan**
  - Business Relief Program: (part of Borough program)
  - Utilities Program -
  - Food Security: \$40,000
  - Moorage Assistance Round one: \$300,000 Up to 25% of fee. March through December.
  - Rent and Mortgage Assistance

# Round 2 September to December

- Borough:
  - Business Relief \$3.5 million (\$2 million Borough (includes Micro business program \$1.4 million from City of Ketchikan) Maximum \$50,000. (30% reduction in revenues in 3<sup>rd</sup> Qtr.) Program expanded to include Fisherman and companies with out-of-borough revenues)
  - Rent and Mortgage Assistance \$1, 590,000 (household income limit \$84K) \$1,200 per month through December.
  - Non-Profit Organization General Support: \$350,000
  - PPE supplies and equipment: \$50,000
  - Reimbursement of Borough Expenditures: July-December, TBD
- City of Ketchikan
  - Rent Assistance up to \$1,200 per month through December. (similar to Borough's program)
  - Moorage Fee Assistance: Up to 25% of fee. Continuation of Round 1 program.
  - Child Care Assistance \$350,000
