Napaskiak Tribal Council Emergency Order Guidelines for the Native Village of Napaskiak concerning COVID-19 (Corona Virus)

- 1. a) avoid inter-village travel as much as possible.
 - b) Chronic patients with hospital appointments are permitted to travel at this time, all other appointments should be rescheduled for a later date.
 - c) those who work outside of Napasklak are advised to go straight home/ stay home when arrive from Bethel or other villages/ no house to house visits, especially to homes where elders live
 - d) if you have traveled recently from a community with known COVID-19 cases, you are advised to stay home for at least 14 days till you are cleared of the COVID-19
- 2. a) Water treatment plant will close daily at 6pm Monday through Friday to distribute water, weekends till 4pm. No water tokens will be distributed from Napaskiak Tribal till further notice.
 - b) Water/Sewer services will be served as usual, but no signatures will be collected
- 3. a) Napaskiak Tribal will close its doors to public on March 23, 2020. All service will be conducted though phone.
 - b) water/sewer payments will only be done through phone using debit or credit cards.
 - c) gaming department will not cash checks until further notice
- 4. all gatherings are suspended such as pull tabs, meetings, etc.
- 5. a) curfew will remain at 9pm daily for school age children
 - b) advise children and family to avoid house to house visiting
- 6. Clinic will be in operation under the discretion of Yukon Kuskokwim Health Corporation
- 7. store will be under their own discretion, call the store if you have any questions
- 8. City of Napaskiak will also have their guidelines, call City of Napaskiak for their guidelines
- 9. Reminder Napaskiak is a dry community, help us remain healthy, our police will be helping those who need medical attention

Following the Napaskiak Tribal Constitution, Napaskiak Tribal is acting and concerned of the safety and wellbeing of our community and to protect our people. Also abiding by the CDC, Federal and State COVID-19 guidelines. This emergency order will be updated periodically as needed.
