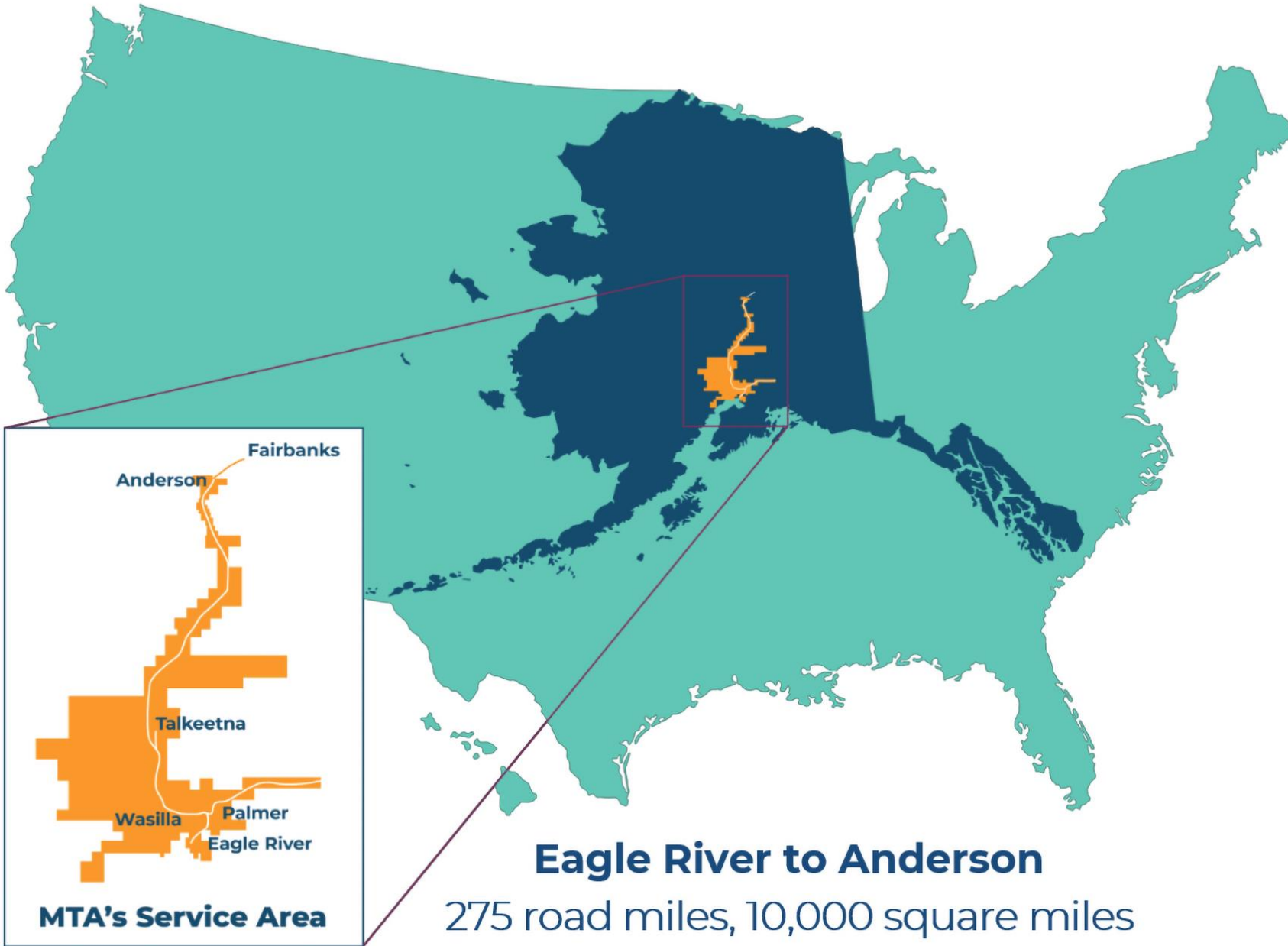

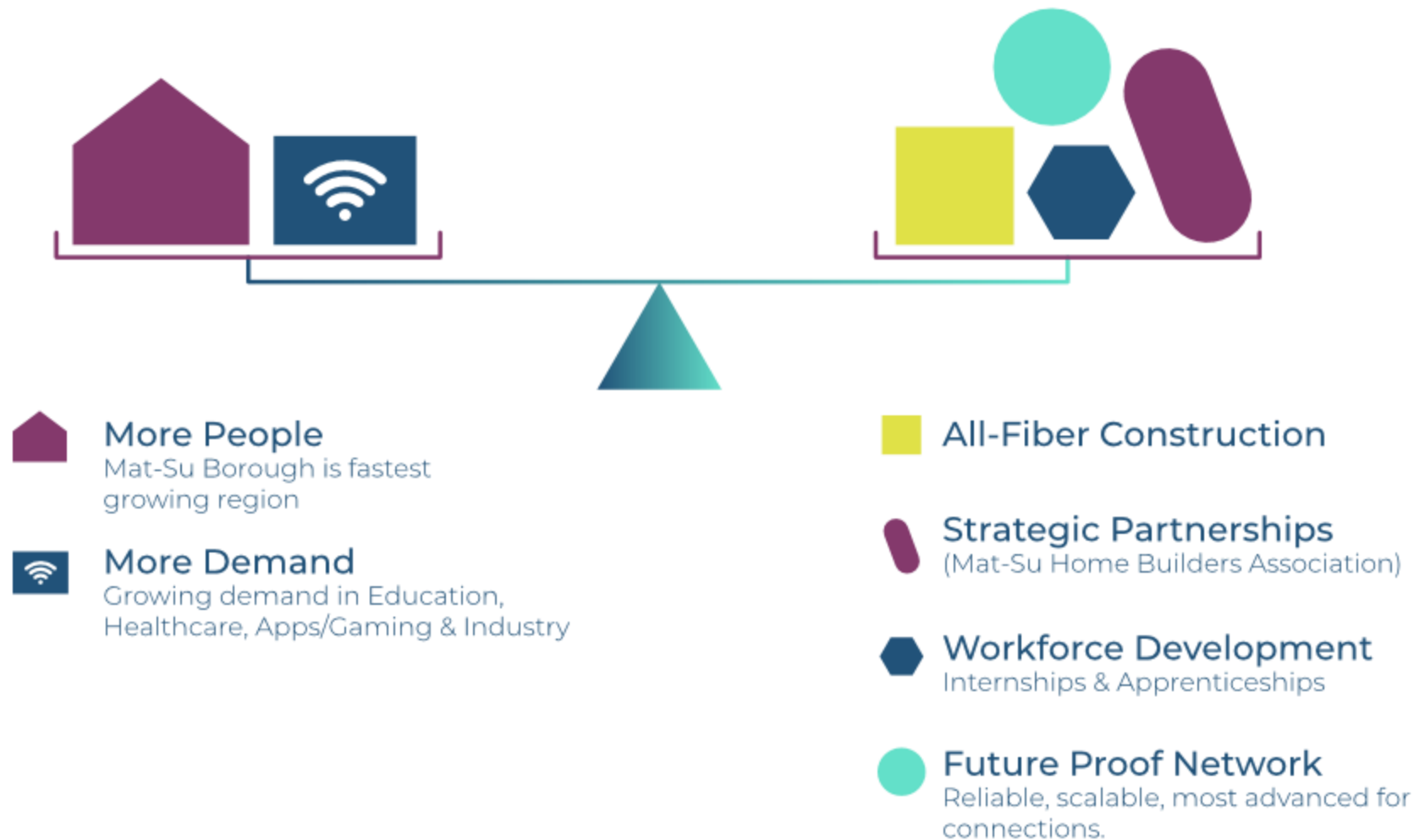

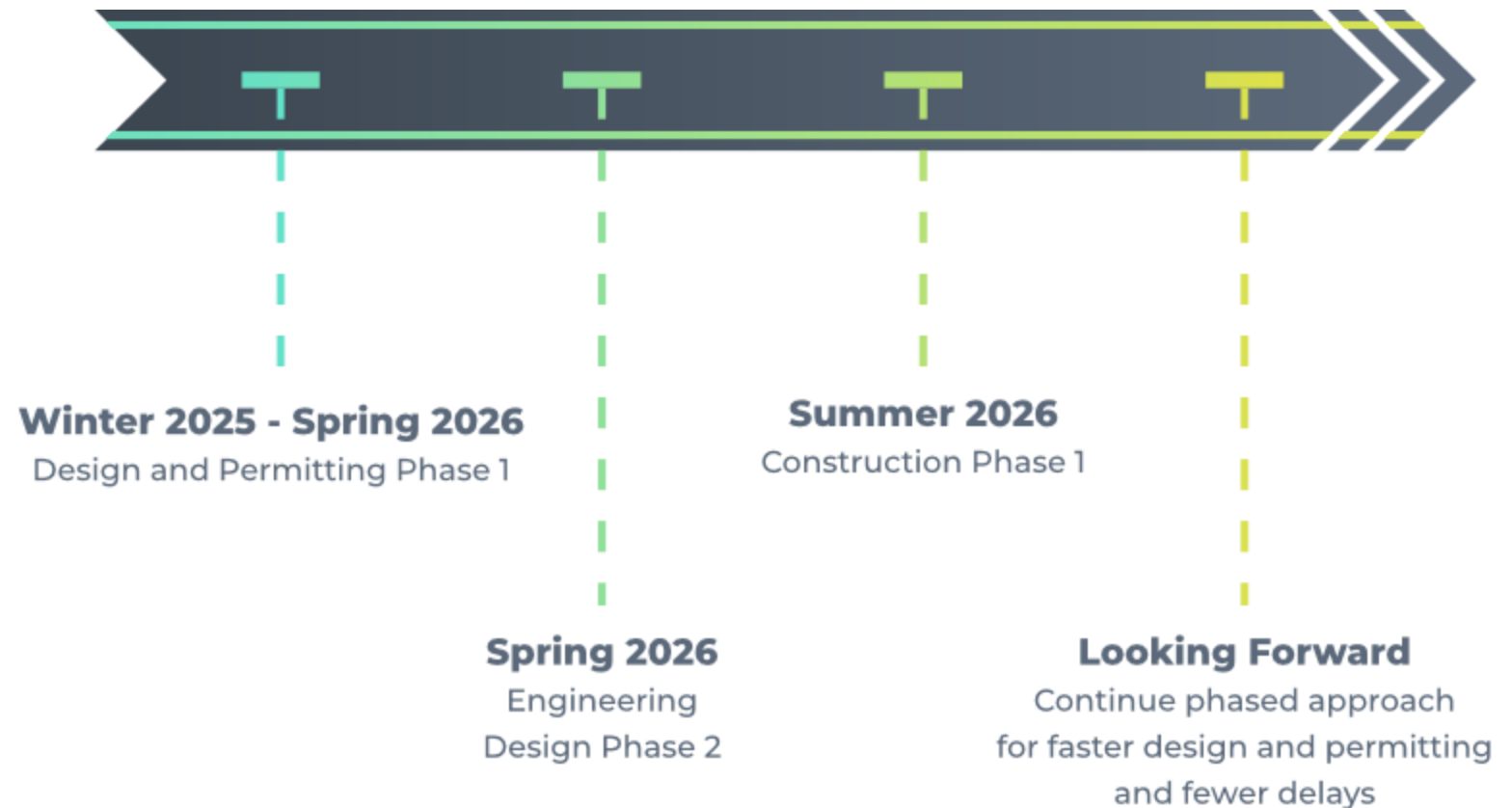
ReConnect 4 Grant Project Summary

- Fiber deployment to communities along the Parks Highway connecting 625 locations to fiber.



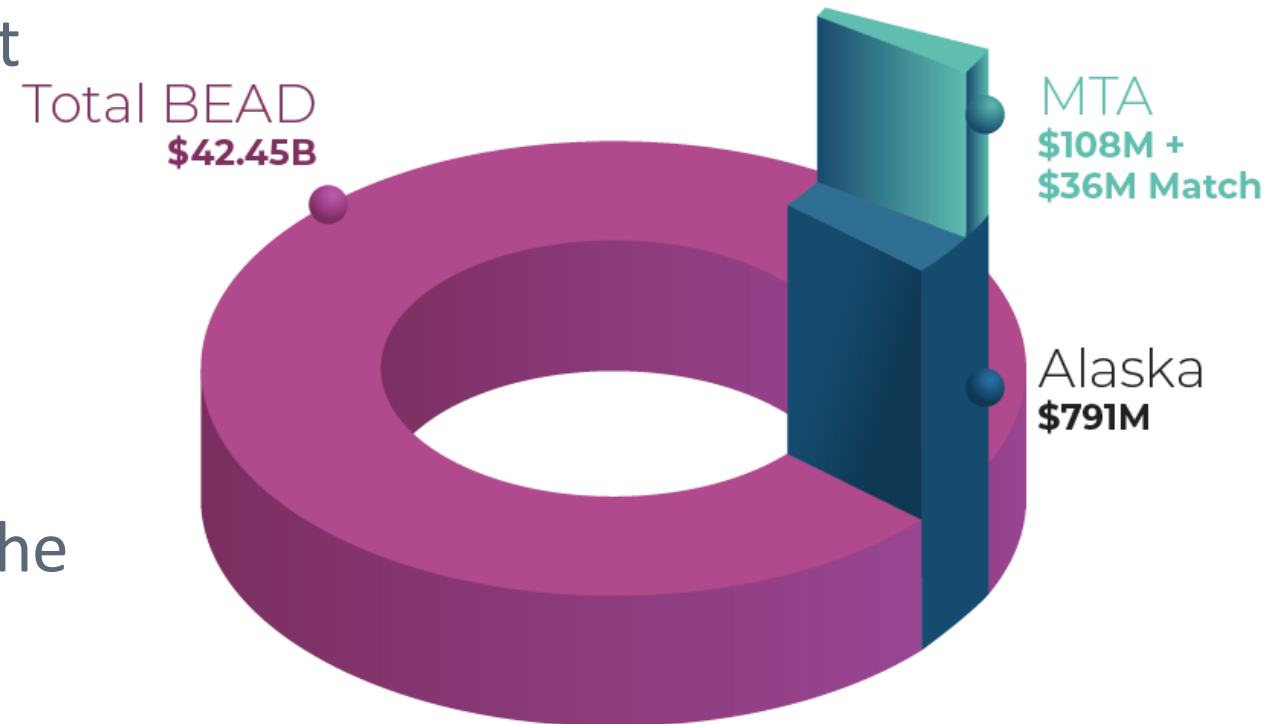
BEAD Success

- Provisional Award
 - 10,485 locations (23% of State Award)
 - \$108,000,000 Regional investment
 - \$36,000,000 MTA Match
 - 100% Fiber deployment
